T-Mobile Offers Significant Telephone Savings to Members of FACT

EDWARDSVILL, IL, August 22, 2008 - The Federation of American Consumers and Travelers (**FACT**) has signed an agreement with T-Mobile which will result in significant savings for FACT members.

FACT is an association of consumers, formed under the not-for-profit corporation laws of the District of Columbia in 1984. The association currently furnishes more than 20 benefits -- ranging from dental care discounts and medical insurance to prescription drug discounts and college scholarships -- to some 1,000,000 consumers nationwide.

Under the FACT/T-Mobile Affinity Agreement:

- There will be a 12% discount on Monthly Service Charges for all new and existing T-Mobile FACT members and employees. This discount represents an exclusive offering only available to the FACT members.

In addition, FACT members will receive:

- Custom discounted pricing (for new activations) on cell phones, PDAs and promotional items offered to FACT members and employees (to be reviewed quarterly)
- The ability to order T-Mobile National Business Rate Plans (greater value and feature rich vs standard consumer plans) on their personal lines.
- Waiver of Activation Fees (a \$35.00 savings).

“This new arrangement is a perfect example,” says FACT Managing Director Vicki Rolens, “of how consumers save *far* more money by joining FACT than they could save on their own.” She pointed out that FACT dues are just \$36 per year whereas, through the T-Mobile program, members will save the \$35 activation fee -- plus 12% off monthly telephone service charges and other product/service discounts. “I believe,” Rolens adds, “it’s what people call a ‘no-brainer’.” “The \$36 dues reduce a member’s telephone costs by potentially *hundreds* of dollars ... AND entitle the member to all the other benefits and savings that FACT makes possible.”
